3-B. Consideration and Approval of a Resolution Authorizing a Development Agreement between Cameron County and the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority

Mr. Pete Sepulveda, Jr., RMA Coordinator introduced the item and turned over the presentation to Mr. Dave Gordon, Financial Advisor with Estrada Hinojosa. Mr. Gordon went over the financial structure of the proposed SH 550 financing that is being proposed to Commissioners Court. Mr. Gordon handed out the attached flow chart showing the flow of funds as well as an amortization schedule. Mr. Gordon went into detail on the various reserve funds that are part of the bond covenants and how each fund will be structured and funded and over what period of time. There was a discussion with the Board on how the funds will flow including the Trustee's role in the transaction and after the debt is sold. A discussion on the operation and maintenance expenses was also reviewed in detail. A complete explanation on the Vehicle Registration Fees and the portion of the fees that are obligated with the first bond issue was also discussed with the Board. Cameron County's Bond Counsel, Mr. Dan Martinez went over the Trust Agreement. A discussion on the retirement of the debt and the period for such was also held with the Board. The Board discussed the payment of an administrative fee to the County and suggested modifications to the amount. Mr. Martinez briefed the Board on the meetings and discussions held with the State Attorney General's office and the role they will play in this transaction. The Board discussed the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority's ability and the capacity for the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority to borrow for any future projects. Bond Counsel advised the Board that the County would have to approve any future borrowing if there is any debt outstanding on this transaction. The Financial Advisor talked about the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority's ability to finance the transaction by themselves in a period of five to ten years in the future and retire the debt from this transaction. A discussion was held on the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority's representative for inclusion in the Trust Agreement. The Board had a consensus for the Chairman to represent the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority along with the Financial Advisor. The County would be represented by the County Judge and the Financial Advisor.



BE IT RESOLVED THAT ON THE 6^{TH} DAY OF JUNE, 2012, THE CAMERON COUNTY REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY CONVENED IN SPECIAL SESSION, AND UPON THE REQUEST OF THE CAMERON COUNTY BOARD OF DIRECTORS, THE FOLLOWING ITEM WAS OFFERED AND ADOPTED, TO WIT:

"CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN CAMERON COUNTY AND THE CAMERON COUNTY REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY"

- WHEREAS, the Cameron County Commissioners Court (the "Court") of Cameron County, Texas (the "County") has previously authorized proceedings related to the financing of the "State Highway 550 Direct Connector Transportation Project" (the "Project") with tax and revenue bonds (the "Bonds") in the approximate amount of \$40,000,000; and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Project to be developed by the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority ("the Authority") will benefit the County and its residents through improved mobility, increased safety, enhanced economic development, and expansion of the tax base which will result in increased revenue to support the County and the provision of services to resident; and
- WHEREAS, to obtain a portion of the amounts necessary to develop the Project, the Authority has requested that the County issue the Bonds and the County has agreed to make available the net proceeds from the sale thereof, to the Authority pursuant to the terms of the Development Agreement (the "Development Agreement") attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the Development Agreement provides the terms, the sources, and security to the County for repayment of the Bonds to the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority of Cameron County, Texas that form and substance of the Development Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby approved.

AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE COSTS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

DESCRIPTION:

An Interlocal Agreement between the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (CTRMA) and the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA) for a toll collection system was made effective January 27, 2010. Within that Agreement, the CTRMA was to provide a toll collection system for CCRMA. Section II-2 "ACTIONS" includes a cost reference that cannot be exceeded without written consent of the CCRMA. CCRMA is requesting that a second tolling location be equipped with another toll system similar to the first toll system installation.
