



Notice and Opportunity to Comment West Boulevard Project From FM 3248 to FM 802

CSJs: 0921-06-340

Cameron County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA) are proposing to initiate the Advanced Project Development (APD) for the proposed construction of West Boulevard (Blvd.) from FM 3248/Alton Gloor Blvd. to FM 802/Ruben M. Torres Blvd. in Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are receiving this notice, our records indicate that you own property that is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

The proposed project would be constructed within the right-of-way (ROW) of a former railroad which varies in width between 64 and 79 feet. The proposed project would consist of a two-lane urban roadway with two 12-foot-wide travel lanes, 10-foot-wide shoulders and one 6-foot-wide sidewalk constructed adjacent to and east of the West Rail Trail, a 12-foot-wide shared use path. At the proposed intersections with FM 3248, Morrison Road, and FM 802, the proposed project would consist of two 12-foot-wide travel lanes, one 14-foot-wide center left turn lane, and 3-foot-wide shoulders. Morrison Road would be upgraded to include a 14-foot-wide left turn approximately 315 feet in length from each side of the intersection with the proposed West Blvd. The proposed roadway would be constructed parallel to the West Rail Trail and would include an intersection with Madrid Avenue located approximately 0.43 mile south of FM 3248.

Maps and drawings showing the project location, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the CCRMA office at 3470 Carmen Avenue, Rancho Viejo, TX 78575. 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What is being proposed?

The Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA) and the Texas Department of Transportation-Pharr District (TxDOT) are proposing to develop a roadway project that would construct a two-lane roadway and a sidewalk within the former right-of-way of the West Rail railroad from Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 3248/Alton Gloor Boulevard to FM 802/Ruben M Torres Boulevard in Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas. The new roadway would be named West Boulevard.

Why is this project needed?

The overall objective of constructing West Boulevard is to improve the operational efficiency of the roadway network in Brownsville. By building the roadway in the former location of a railroad, CCRMA and TxDOT will avoid displacing any residents or businesses and minimize the environmental impact.

Benefits of the project

When complete, West Boulevard will provide the people of Brownsville with a multi-modal corridor that will allow cyclists, pedestrians, and motorists a new route to travel from north to south. With its intersection at Madrid Avenue, West Boulevard would also provide a new way for students and their parents to get to and from Pullam Elementary.

About the Project


- West Boulevard would intersect, from north to south: FM 3248, Madrid Avenue, Morrison Road, and FM 802.
- The project would not displace the West Rail Trail.
- A six-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway would provide a new north-south travel route for pedestrians.
