



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

FM 1846 (OSCAR WILLIAMS ROAD)

From Business 77 to San Jose Ranch Road

The Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA), in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Cameron County, and the City of San Benito, is proposing to widen and reconstruct FM 1846 (Oscar Williams Road) from Business 77 to San Jose Ranch Road in Cameron County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Wednesday, July 29, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. and will remain online for at least 15 days.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov (keyword: FM 1846 (Oscar Williams Rd.)) and <https://ccrma.org/hearings-meetings-and-notice-schedules/>. If you do not have internet access, you may call (956) 621-5573 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, the CCRMA and TxDOT are providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on July 30, 2026 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Veterans Memorial Academy Cafeteria located at 2115 N. Oscar Williams Rd. in San Benito, TX 78586**



The scope of the proposed project would include widening 1.62 miles of the existing two-lane rural roadway to four lanes within a proposed 140-foot-wide right of way (ROW). The proposed 82-foot-wide roadway would consist of four 12-foot-wide travel lanes, a 14-foot-wide continuous left turn lane, two 10-foot-wide shoulders, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path on one side of the roadway. Drainage would be handled by roadside ditches. An asphalt overlay would be included as part of the proposed project. Approximately 0.1 miles of incidental construction would occur north of San Jose Ranch Rd. to ensure proper roadway transition. The proposed project is anticipated to require 6.95 acres of new ROW. The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain. No wetlands or Section 4(f) properties are anticipated in the project area.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the CCRMA office by calling (956) 621-5573.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at CCRMA office at 3461 Carmen Ave., Rancho Viejo, TX 78575. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you.
