



**Notice of Public Meeting**  
**Outer Parkway**  
**From Interstate Highway 69E/US Highway 77 to FM 106/General Brant Road**  
**CSJ 0921-06-283**  
**Cameron County, Texas**

Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA) is proposing to construct a new location four lane divided highway (Outer Parkway) from Interstate Highway 69E/US Highway 77 (I-69E/US 77) to Farm-to-Market Road 106/General Brant Road (FM 106) in Cameron County, Texas (proposed project). This notice advises the public that CCRMA will be conducting a public meeting on the proposed project. The public meeting will follow an “open house” format that will allow attendees to arrive and depart at their convenience. Attendees will be able to view hard copies of project materials, ask questions of CCRMA staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The public meeting will be held on Thursday, August 27, 2026, from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm at the Rio Hondo Civic Center, 121 N. Arroyo Boulevard, Rio Hondo, Texas 78583.**

The proposed project would traverse unincorporated areas of northwestern Cameron County. The proposed project would be constructed in two phases; Phase I (interim design) would primarily construct two 12-foot wide travel lanes (one in each direction) and two 10-foot wide shoulders (one in each direction). Phase II (ultimate design) would consist of a highway with two main travel lanes and two frontage road lanes, where justified, in each direction (eastbound and westbound). The proposed project would be constructed within a right of way (ROW) approximately 300 feet wide within most of the project limits in both phases, expanding to 500 feet wide at intersections with existing roadways during Phase II. The project would be approximately 22 miles in length. In addition to I-69E/US 77 and FM 106, roadways that would intersect the proposed project include FM 507, the future extension of FM 509, FM 2925, FM 803, and FM 1847. The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional ROW and potentially displace residential and non-residential structures. The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and involve an action in a floodplain.

The public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who
