This Supplemental Work Authorization No. 7 to Work Authorization No. 8 is made pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Base Contract, effective February 16, 2006, hereinafter identified as the "Agreement", entered into by and between Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (the "AUTHORITY") and HNTB Corporation (the "CONSULTANT").

- **Part 4.** This Supplemental Work Authorization No. 7 to Work Authorization No. 8 is effective as of December 14, 2010, and shall extend the termination date to June 30, 2011, unless extended by a Supplemental Work Authorization.
- Part 5. This Supplemental Work Authorization No. 7 to Work Authorization No. 8 does not waive the parties' responsibilities and obligations provided under the Agreement.
