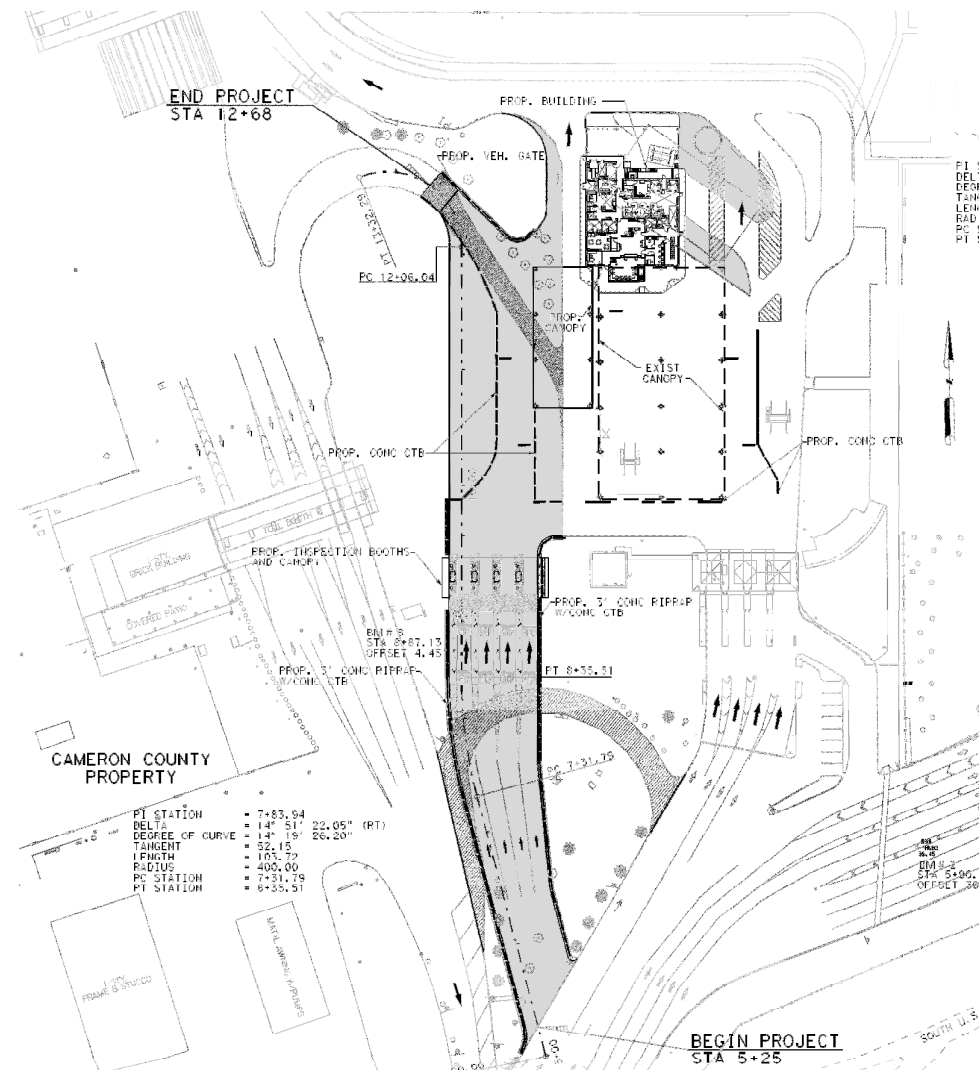

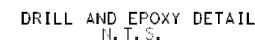

(15' MAXIMUM SPACING).
