## **B. INVITATION TO BID**

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For the construction of the FM 1847 SW Project, from 1<sup>st</sup> Street to Resaca Street (on west side of FM 1847), which consists of: of curb ramps, sidewalks, signage, striping and miscellaneous pedestrian elements along FM 1847.

**Payment for the project will be made as defined in the specifications.**

Signed/valid Proposals for the above project will be received physically by Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA), Attn: Pete Sepulveda, Executive Director, 3461 Carmen Avenue, Rancho Viejo, Texas 78575, **until 3:00 P.M. C.S.T., Wednesday, August 30, 2023.** Bids will be opened and read aloud at the Conference room at the same location at 3:05 P.M. C.S.T. (as per Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority time clock) on deadline due date.

The work under this Contract shall be Substantially Complete within sixty (60) working days after the initial notice to proceed (“NTP”). The Contractor will be allowed up to an additional thirty (30) calendar days for Final Acceptance. The contract time includes the mobilization and materials procurement period. The complete list of estimated quantities is in the bid tab. The principal items of work are as follows:

- Sidewalk
- Striping
- Miscellaneous Pedestrian Elements
- Curb Ramps
- Signage

To receive and subsequently submit Official Proposals for this Contract, prospective bidders shall, meet the following requirements:

- Be registered with the State of Texas.
- Be eligible to work on Federal Projects.
- Be prequalified by TxDOT to perform the work at the time of bidding.

Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority cannot be held liable in the event a party is unable to submit a valid bid due to delay in the prequalification procedure. Securing prequalification and the timing thereof shall at all times be the sole responsibility of the Prospective Bidder.
