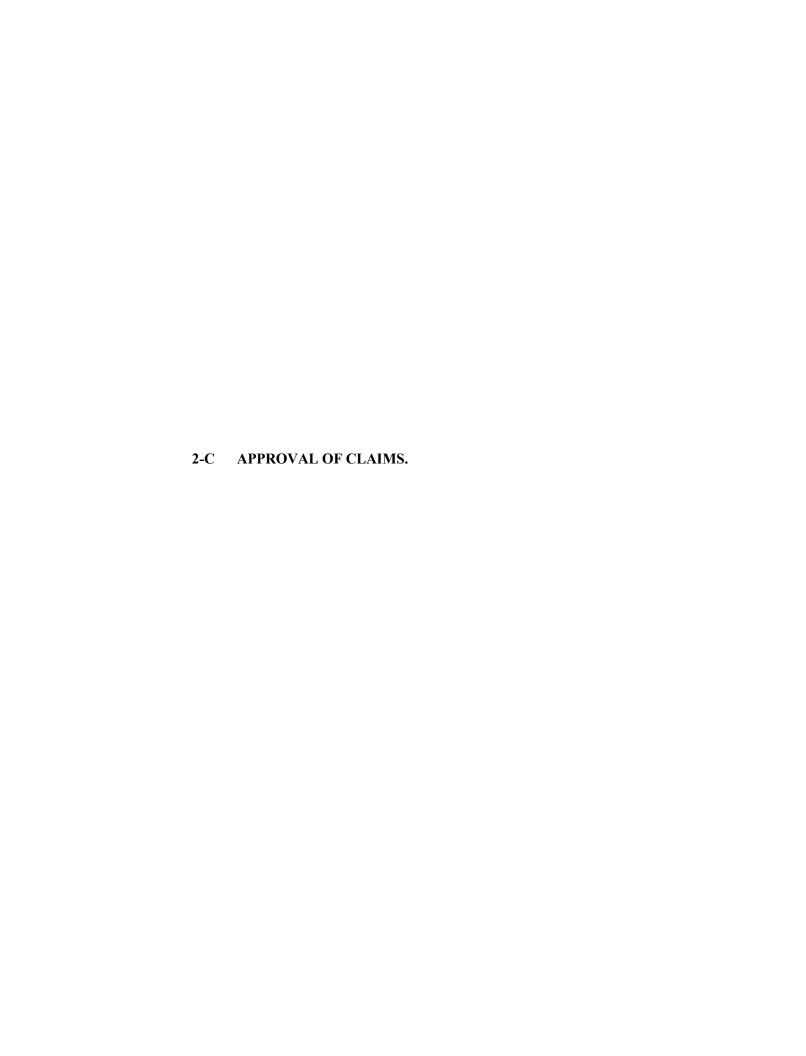

The solicitation was strictly qualifications based with no cost estimates provided. Each response was evaluated in the following categories:

Staff is requesting that the Board Authorize us to commence negotiations for a final contract with the sole participant R.R.P. Consulting Engineers, LLC.

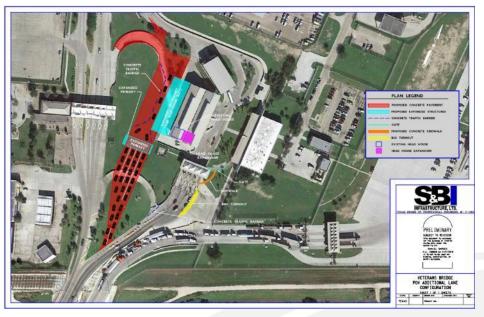
