





Project Summary



- Reconstruct and widen existing roadway to provide shoulders, continuous left turn lane,

- Provide right turn lane at schools and intersections
- Construct one new bridge and reconstruct/widen an existing bridge
- 7.97 acres of proposed right-of-way
- No residential or business relocations anticipated
